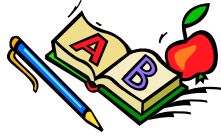

Concepts

- Regrouped 10 ones as 1 ten to show a number in another way
- Decided, when adding a 2-digit number and a 1-digit number, if the ones need to be regrouped
- Added 2-digit numbers with and without regrouping
- Subtracted 2-digit numbers with and without regrouping
- *Subtraction facts: -9, -10*

- Acrostic Poems



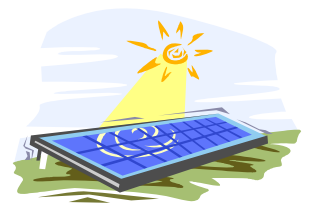
Social Studies
