Join Clifford for a week of fun adventures in learning!

### **Adventures with Curious George**

Curious George can always find some adventure and so can you as we develop skills in language arts, social studies, and math. Learn how to be kind, helpful, and honest just like Curious George! You will have a chance to listen to stories, create your own stories and drawings, and learn about the world in this fun class with Curious George.

### **Adventures with Eric Carle Books**

Do you like *The Very Hungry Caterpillar*, *The Grouchy Ladybug*, or *The Mixed Up Chameleon*? Join us as we read lots of Eric Carle stories and hear how each of his main characters learns to be kind, helpful, and honest. Then have fun creating your own stories or finding all the math you can in some of the stories we read. You will have a wonderful adventure with these classic childhood stories.

### **American Cuisine**

Become a chef and recreate some of the foods from different regions of our country. Visit the Midwest, the Rocky Mountain area, the South, the New England area, and one more area through the food of the region. Find out about recipes and traditions from different cities across the United States!

### **Art, Music, and Dance from Around the World**

Come share some wonderful adventures with us as we travel the world! We will be exploring a new country every week! Visit Mexico, Japan, Ireland, and Spain through arts and crafts, stories, music, and dance! We will do everything from making piñatas to learning how to use chopsticks like a pro and dance an Irish ceili. So, hurry, grab your passport, and join us for some fabulous fun!

### **Arts and Crafts**

Enjoy discovering your inner artist as you create stationery, papier-mâché creations, string art, and many other fantastic masterpieces. Every day we will experience a new activity!

### **Babysitting Training and CPR**

Do you want to be a babysitter or have you already been babysitting and want to learn more skills? This course is designed for students 11 through 15 years of age. All participants must show proof of age (e.g. birth certificate) on the first day of class and must be 11 years old by the last day of class. Students will learn how to protect children from accident and injury, first aid for choking and bleeding, and CPR skills for breathing emergencies in both infants and children. Other skills included are securing babysitting jobs, setting fees, and caring for infants as well as growth and development, discipline, and problem solving when a child is crying or sick. Participants will receive *The Babysitter's Handbook and Backpack*. All participants will receive a one-year certification in both infant and child CPR along with an American Red Cross Certificate. *Class size is limited to 12 students.*

### **Basketball in the Gym**

Learn basketball skills, work on your ball handling, and perfect your shooting form. We will work on skill development for the first hour and then play informal basketball games for an hour. We need a minimum of 10 players.

### **Bigfoot and Other Legendary Creatures**

This is an entertaining study of legendary creatures such as Bigfoot and the Loch Ness monster taught by an intrepid, young adventurer (and alum) with actual field experience searching for Bigfoot. We will deal with known facts about these creatures as well as the teacher's own conjectures, tracking techniques, and other important information.

### **Boogie 'n Blues**

Are you ready to boogie and join our band? Learn piano and theory basics with the *Twelve-Bar Blues* and real-time rhythm. Chords, chord function, improvisation, rhythmic comps, and melodic riffs equal ensemble fun. Pre-requisite: ten fingers ready to jam. You will receive materials that are yours to keep when the class is over. *Class size is limited to 8 students.*

### **Bowling**

Do you think bowling looks easy? Think again! See how difficult it really can be to get all the pins down in either one or two rolls of the ball. In this class, you learn how to keep score in bowling, and then go to the bowling lanes the final four days to see how good a player you really are. No equipment is necessary. Shoes and balls may be rented at the lanes.

### **Build an Obstacle Course**

Enjoy the challenge of creating a new obstacle course every day. You will have a chance to exercise your creativity and develop fitness as you race through each new obstacle course. You will have fun in this self-paced competitive and cooperative environment.

### **Calling All Angels**

Discover angels as you do arts and crafts, read stories, and watch movies. We will even dance and sing! Learn all about angels in all aspects of life!

### **Card Games**

Do you love to play card games? Have you ever heard of euchre, hearts, spades, pinochle, canasta, or spoons? These are all cards games to play with a deck of cards. You will learn there are many different ways to use a deck of cards!

### **Celebrating Popcorn Classics**

*Superman, Star Wars, Raiders of the Lost Ark...*each day we will celebrate a different *popcorn* classic. These are the flicks that leave you with the scent of popcorn in your nose and the distant memory of the summer heat outside!

### **Cheer**

Join us and have fun learning to cheer! We will learn basic cheer stunts, moves, and routines. Rah, Rah, Rah!

### **Classic Monster Movie Madness**

Crack open a refreshing drink and smell the popcorn as you sit back to enjoy some of Hollywood's classic monster movies such as *Frankenstein* and *Dracula*! Learn about the origins of these scare-fests and their place in our history. The balcony is open!

You are sure to have fun in this class! Learn to draw with pencil, pen, charcoal, and paint! Learn new techniques and refine your skills. Have fun discovering your creativity!

Healthy eating leads to a healthy body. Learn to make healthy recipes that will fuel your bodies for more fun summer activities. We will create nutritionally balanced meals each day. Then we will have fun eating and cleaning! You will leave class with a stack of recipe cards to take home so you can share your healthy recipes with your family.

### **Essays Made Easy**

Does the thought of writing a five-paragraph essay about a piece of literature give you the shivers or make you smile? Learn the process, step-by-step, on a novel of your choice. Be ready to rock on the summer reading list while your classmates shake in their shoes!

### **Fantasy Baseball**

Do you follow baseball on Sports Center or in the newspaper? Have you ever played fantasy baseball before? If you have or if you haven't and you just enjoy following baseball statistics in the newspaper, then this is the class for you! You will draft your own fantasy baseball team and watch the team throughout the week learning tips about who to play and how to project who will do well.

### **Gardening for Kids**

Learn how to grow plants, flowers, and even vegetables in the garden and beautiful plants in the house. We will be painting our own terra cotta flower pots, making decorative stones, and creating other decorative garden items. Have fun playing in the dirt in the All Saints' garden!

### **Golf**

You will learn about savings accounts, bonds, stocks, and mutual funds as well as how to read the financial pages in the newspaper. Learn how to manage your money and the importance of saving and investing for the future!

### **Guitar: Move, Sing, Strum, and Drum**

Would you like to learn to play the guitar? Join our introductory guitar class where you will have ensemble experiences with music as you learn basic chords and strumming. We will add drumming, singing, and movement to complete your musical experience!

### **Guitar: Pick, Strum, and Drum**

Join our explorations into the world of the guitar. You will experience ensemble fun with pop, rock, and classical sounds. Enjoy learning a touch of drumming, too!

### **Gym Time**

Join your friends to develop your fitness and play games! We will have fun learning new games each day as we explore hula hoops, bean bags, balls, racquets, and parachutes. The gym is a cool place to play on a hot day!

### **Gymnastics**

### **Individualized Reading Comprehension**

Would you like to become a better reader or increase your reading speed? Each student's reading comprehension level will be determined by individualized testing and then an individualized program will be developed to help each student. The program will include a variety of methods to increase reading comprehension and speed.

### **Introduction to Chinese**

To get ready for All Saints' kindergarten program, we will focus on identifying letters and their sounds, applying these sounds to the beginnings and endings of words, and print awareness. We will introduce students to beginning sight words, letter blends, and word families. Students will be singing and wiggling in delight as we work our way through phonics lessons based on the amazingly effective and entertaining *Letter and Word Factory* series by Leapfrog.

## **Kinder Prep: Number Sense**

To get ready for All Saints' kindergarten program, multi sensory activities will be used to excite and inspire all learning styles as we expand on the basic number skills and develop a strong number sense. Students will be sure to be excited as they skip count, classify, sort, and play math games!

## **Know When to Hold 'Em Poker**

Learn how to perfect your poker face in a class designed for beginning players. We will learn the basics of poker, including rules of the game, calculating odds, poker etiquette, betting strategies, tips on how to improve your game, and the art of the bluff!

## **Learn to Knit**

Learn to knit some easy and fun projects. Make hackie sacks, a headband, a belt, and knitted flowers or yarn daisies to jazz up a garment. You can also make pom-poms or over-sized tassels for your house key or a cozy cowl or scarf to keep you warm this winter. Use your creativity to make something for yourself or gifts for others.

Join us and learn everything you need to be a chef! We will learn about the different food groups and proper food handling as we make appetizers, salads, entrees, delicious drinks, and desserts. Learn how math, social skills, and art help you in the kitchen!

## **Loving Life and Literature**

*Tons* of games, snacks, and fun activities are in store for you as we read favorite books and discover the joy of new ones. Each day brings a new book and a new theme. What would happen if it really were *Cloudy with a Chance of Meatballs*?

## **Marvelous Mime and Impish Improv**

Bring out the best in your dramatic self! Learn the special skills of mime acting and the think-on-your-feet excitement of improv

## **Math Games**

Math games are fun and educational, too! Spend the day playing not only your favorites, but also learning some that are new. The objective here is to have fun and to practice the math skills you have learned throughout the year.

### **Math Mania I**

This is a hands-on math class! We will focus on adding and subtracting using games, manipulatives, and activities. This class is ideal for a wide range of learners, as we will be working on basic skills in addition to more complex skills and problem solving!

### **Math Mania II**

This is a hands-on math class! We will focus on multiplying and dividing using games, manipulatives, and activities. Learn or refine your basic skills and work with larger numbers and mental math, and develop different strategies to solve more complex problems.

### **Math Problem Solving and Games**

Join this class to improve your math skills and become a better problem solver. Math facts, fractions, decimals, and percents are a snap when you are practicing with friends and having fun! As you learn group problem solving strategies, you will be amazed at the math problems you will be able to solve!

### **Math with Dr. Cohn**

Dr. Cohn sees math everywhere she looks, do you? This class will allow you to learn new and interesting topics in math. Do you know about pentaminos? Do you want to create some strategy games you can play at home? Have you always wanted to know how to solve those toothpick problems or water jug problems? Join us and come prepared to learn everything you always wanted to know about math!

### **Movies and Munchies**

Enjoy watching new movies as well as old favorites in this class. But first, we will create a fun, delicious snack to munch while we marvel at all of the fun antics on our *movie screen*.

### **Museum Madness**

### **Music Time**

Music Time is an introduction to keyboard and piano playing, piano finger readiness, rhythms, music reading concepts, movement, and *solfege* singing. Parents are encouraged to share in class time and make music with their children. These introductory classes provide a strong basis for continuing classes. You will receive a book and CD that are yours to keep when the class is over. *Class size is limited to 8 students.*

### **My Bread Plate or Yours?**

Have you ever gone to an elegant restaurant and wondered which bread plate was yours or which fork to use with your dessert? Have you ever had questions about how to write a party invitation or thank you note? Traveling is a grand adventure, but do you know how to greet politely people from around the world? Come and have fun with us as we become experts on etiquette and perfect manners! You will learn to meet and greet people from different countries in different languages, design your own personal stationery, and be an expert on table manners whether you are on a picnic in Oak Creek or dining at the White House! On the last day of class, we will celebrate your new-found skills at a graduation luncheon at Vincent's Restaurant!

### **Outdoor Art**

Do you like art and the out-of-doors? This class is for you. Paint, create *natural* art, and explore your creativity. Each day, we will try a different media as we learn to appreciate, enjoy, and describe the outdoors through art!

### **Paper Doll Fashions**

Explore fashion through paper dolls. Every week, we will be looking at different fashion trends as we cut out outfits for our paper dolls! You will get a book of cardboard dolls and fashions each week. Have fun as you improve your fine motor skills cutting out clothes of your choice. Create your own unique fashion style! We will focus on different fashion trends each week: Glamour, Designer, International, and Fashion through the Ages.

### **Passport to Cooking**

Visit Italy, Egypt, Mexico, Spain, and the United States through cooking, arts and crafts, and interesting facts. Learn about each country with all of your senses! We will stir up skills involving measurement, following a sequence of directions, writing recipes, and kitchen safety.

### **Penguin Parade**

Let's learn about penguins! We will meet a penguin named Rob who will talk to us about colors and a penguin named Eggy who can count. We will read and sing Sandra Boyton's stories, *My Personal Penguin* and *Penguin Lament*. Then, we will create some clever penguin crafts. At the end of the week, we will disguise ourselves as penguins and have a parade!

### **PianoFonics**

Make your ten fingers work together, learn some songs, play with a *midi* background accompaniment, and learn the language of music! PianoFonics introduces students to the four basic skills of piano playing: *Rhythm* with the Twelve- Bar Blues, *Hand Coordination* with transposition, *Reading* with intervals and Guide Notes, and *Music Vocabulary* with alphabet theory and keyboard geography. You will receive materials that are yours to keep when the class is over. *Class size is limited to 8 students.*

### **Pizza, Pizza, Pizza**

Join us and learn to prepare several variations of something everyone loves—pizza! You will make pesto and tomato style pizza, chicken and garlic Alfredo pizza, BBQ chicken pizza, personal party pizzas, and fresh sugar cookie dessert pizzas. I'll bet you can't wait to sink your teeth into these tasty delights!

### **Protractor Mini-Golf**

Miniature golf is a lot of fun, but what can be even more fun is designing the course! Create different miniature golf courses and learn the math behind how to play the perfect shot for every hole. We will be using math to find the lengths and angles that it will take to create the best courses.

### **Puppetry!**

Explore the wonderful world of puppets in this week long creativity fest. You will learn to make a paper bag puppet, a sock puppet, a stage puppet, and a marionette. Student created plays will be staged, filmed, and presented. Enjoy acting without getting on stage by using your puppet to pretend you are someone else!

### **Puzzles and Games**

Take off your shoes, grab a bean bag chair, and relax on a hot summer afternoon playing games that can help improve your thinking in math. Learn some new games and play some old favorites, or help us put together the fun jigsaw puzzles and math puzzles scattered around the room. Relax and have fun!

### **Quilting**

You'll *piece* a geometric pattern quilt top using the sewing machine. Then, we will either tie it like a comforter or quilt the top and backing together. You may make a wall hanging or a small quilt!

## **Religion 101**

So you want to know more about religion at All Saints'? Join us as we explore the wonderful stories in the *Bible* and the life of Jesus. We will also talk about chapel etiquette and take field trips to spiritual places on campus. Join us for a spiritual journey this summer!

## **Science Fiction Writing**

Each day, explore a different science fiction movie—followed by a writing activity. Have fun watching clips from *Star Wars*, *The Day the Earth Stood Still*, *Apollo 13* and other classic *B* movies. Then, learn to write a movie review, persuasive essay, literary analysis, and mini-research essay. This will be a fun class for all ages with different materials to match each student's level.

## **Scrapbooking**

Join in the fun as we learn how to scrapbook our cherished photos and preserve the precious memories of our lives! You will spend the week arranging and embellishing your album. Make sure to bring your photographs and lots of creativity. We will provide the rest! The theme is Babies and Birthdays.

You will master prat falls and stage fights, apply clown make-up, put on clown costumes and wigs, learn to tell jokes like a clown, devise clown skits, and prepare for the final performance to your family and friends on Friday at 2:30 p.m. *Class size is limited to 18 students, so book early for the craziest show in town! Join us and learn how to make a vest, handbag, a skirt, or even pajamas! Learn the basics of sewing by hand and with a sewing machine.

## **Sim City and Keyboarding practice**

### **Tennis**

### **Teambuilding**

### **Virtual Trip**

### **Watercolor**
