GENERAL INFORMATION

Registration and Payment

Register early! Each class has a limited number of spaces available for students over various grade levels. Registrations will be processed on a first come, first served basis. Registration forms will receive a date and time stamp, and postmarks will be considered. **Be sure to complete the entire form – There are two sides.** Registrations without a completed registration form and a check for the full tuition will not be processed until all monies are received and the form is finished. Checks should be made payable to *ASEDS Summer 2008*. Upon receipt of the form and payment, parents/guardians will receive a confirmation letter.

Savings for Early Registration

Parents who register their children for the summer program on or before March 31, 2008, will receive a **5%** discount on the total fee for all *Summer 2008* courses.

Low Enrollment

Occasionally, a class will need to be cancelled due to low enrollment. Students may choose another course, or parents will receive a full refund for the cancelled class.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

Parents are responsible for the entire tuition regardless of absences for whatever reason. Refunds minus a **25%** processing fee will be returned to parents who submit a written request at least three weeks before the class begins.

Behavior Policy

Each student and his or her parent/guardian are required to sign the behavior contract on the registration form. Inappropriate conduct or behavior can result in expulsion from the program without a refund.

Lunch and Snacks

We will be unable to provide lunch. Snacks will be included in all four-hour classes. Students who are attending classes over the lunch hour should bring a sack lunch from home. Lunches will be stored in a refrigerator, and students will eat lunch together in a supervised area.

1. If you are enrolling more than one student, please duplicate the registration form in the center of this brochure. Extra forms are available in the Day School Office. Complete one form for each child.
2. Complete the entire registration form with your list of classes. Calculate the total.
3. Deduct **5%** if registering on or before March 31, 2008. The registration form and tuition must be postmarked by March 31, 2008. Make checks payable to *ASEDS Summer 2008*.
